Assessment

The course follows the AQA specification and is assessed internally at the end of each unit of work in line with school policy. Year 10 gives the students opportunities to try new ways of working and build their skills through a series of staff led workshops. The Year 11 portrait project and Controlled Coursework will make up the Coursework Portfolio (60%) with the Externally Set Task being sat at the end of the course (40%).
