### **Assessment**

The course follows the Eduqas specification and is assessed internally at the end of each unit of work in line with school policy. Year 12 gives the students opportunities to try new ways of working and build their skills through a series of staff led workshops. The year 12 personal project and the Year 13 Personal Investigation will make up the Coursework Portfolio (60%) with the Externally Set Task being sat at the end of the course (40%).
