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Skills

Courses based on this specification in Maths should be able to

- Develop fluent knowledge, skills and understanding of mathematical concepts and methods
- Acquire, Select and Apply mathematical techniques to solve problems
- Reason mathematically, make deductions and inferences and draw conclusions
- Comprehend, Interpret and Communicate mathematical information in a variety of forms appropriate to the information in context
- Recall, select and apply mathematical formula

Assessment

Internal assessment takes place through the use of an APP at the end of every topic. This works out at approximately three APPs per half-term. From these students self-select areas for improvement and complete a MyMaths based homework on this. Every term students sit a teacher assessed half-termly test. At the end of year 9 students sit a summative Unit 2 test covering the topics of Number and Algebra. Early in Year 10 students sit a Unit 1 test which covers Data handling and number. By the end of year 10 students are ready to sit a full linear paper, non-calculator, which they do as part of the school's mock exam week. Throughout year 11 students regularly sit past linear papers including a January mock exam.
