Assessment

- Component 2: Health and Social Care Services and Values assessed in June
- Component 3: Health and Wellbeing- examination in February- this is a synoptic unit meaning it cannot be studied until the course work for Component 1 and 2 is completed as it consolidates the learning of topics studied for these components.
