Assessment

The qualification has two assessments externally set by NCFE: one non-exam assessment and one written examined assessment.

The non-exam assessment makes up 50% of the technical award and will assess student's ability to effectively draw together their knowledge, understanding and skills from across all of the teaching content. Students will do the non-exam assessment at the beginning of Year 11.

The written examined assessment makes up 50% of the technical award and will take place in May/June at the end of Year 11. The assessment is written and marked by NCFE external examiners, a variety of assessment questions will be used, including multiple-choice, short-answer and extended response questions.
